Dear Parents/Carers

I would also like to thank you for your continued support with dressing children in the correct uniform on the correct day, bringing children to school on time, hearing the children read, supporting with homework and supporting us in our fundraising for school and for other charities.

As the cost of living rises many of you might find yourselves struggling financially in ways you have never previously experienced. I remember vividly finding things tough with three young daughters and wondering sometimes how we would make ends meet, what could we have for tea that would be nutritious and inexpensive.

If you find yourself struggling and can access benefits, please consider registering for Free School Meals. Every child on Free School Meals will receive at least one nutritious hot meal every day and as we approach the summer, they can even have sandwiches.

Any children who are registered for free School Meals also receive additional funding. We allocate £100 of this per child to be used in school for trips, water bottles, Breakfast and After School Club Attendance and uniform.

If your child is in receipt of this and you are having problems finding funds for a school trip - give the office a buzz and Miss Langley or Miss Evans can organize transferring funds across from our social fund.
