Dear Parents and Carers,

Happy New Year!

Thank you for preparing your children so well for their return to school.

They have returned with a very positive frame of mind and already working extremely hard.

Our covid figures remain low at 4 across school and I am sure that is thanks to you, your vigilance and regular testing. By Monday we should be at zero cases (I have everything crossed).

Staff are also working hard to ensure that classrooms are well-ventilated and touchpoints are cleaned more often. Mrs Little gives all of our toilets an additional clean each day in her own time and Mr Powers foggs each room in school twice a week. We have suspended face to face whole school assemblies and hymns temporarily, whilst maintaining Class, Key Stage 1, Lower Key Stage 2 and Upper Key Stage 2 assemblies.

At lunchtimes children eat at tables with their classmates and hands are sanitised whenever children enter the building and before and after lunch.

Staff wear face masks in communal areas and sanitise after themselves, whilst visitors are asked to show a negative LFD test and confirm they have no symptoms before entering the school grounds.
